Terms and Conditions

By enrolling your child in Beeston Voices Youth Choir, you will thereby be accepting all of the BVYC terms and conditions.

During BVYC's first half term (Tues 3rd March – Tues 31st March) sessions will work on a 'pay as you go' basis. These sessions will be priced at £3 a session after the first free taster session (25th February 2020). After this initial half term, payment for sessions will proceed as follows.

Sessions are booked in half termly blocks at a cost of £18 per half term (regardless of the number of weeks) and are paid for in advance. (The first session for any new child joining is free) Your child's place will automatically be assumed when the half term re-starts unless you state otherwise. An email will be sent one week prior to the half term re-starting, reminding you to make payment via online bank transfer, cheque or cash. If your child no longer wishes to attend, please notify one of the leaders at your earliest convenience. If payment hasn't been received by the end of the first week of each new half term, your child will no longer be able to attend.

The £18 payment is non-refundable. However, if your child no longer wishes to continue in the choir, please do let us know so that we can take them off the register for next half term. If your child misses a session due to any circumstances, may it be an illness or a school trip, unfortunately the session cannot be reimbursed.

If, for any reason a session cannot take place (for example the school hall is not available due to parents' evening or another school event) we will endeavour, where possible, to provide a one-off session to make up for any time missed.
